Predicting

Connecting

Find something that is connected to:

- -my life
- -another book/text
- -things in the world

That reminds me of ...

Noticing

What are the important clues? Have I guessed right or wrong? Is there something I don't understand?

Wondering

What questions pop into my head as I'm reading?
What more do I want to know?
I wonder ...

Picturing/Visualizing

(seeing a picture/movie in my head)
What do you see, hear, feel,

What do you see, hear, feel, smell and taste?

Figuring Out

(When the light bulb goes on!)

What do I understand better after this reading?
